

GPA AND CLASS RANK

Individual subject averages shown on transcripts are not weighted. Grades for AP and Honors courses are weighted only when calculating overall GPA. ECS adds one GPA quality point to Advanced Placement (AP) grades when calculating the GPA. ECS adds 0.5 GPA quality points to Honors grades when calculating the GPA. All non-weighted, numerically-graded courses are considered college preparatory in instruction, evaluation, and rigor. Class rank other than for valedictorian and salutatorian is not computed.

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

Sixty-eight percent of the Class of 2019 received merit, leadership, athletic, and military scholarships. In addition, seniors in the Class of 2019 qualified for the Tennessee Hope Scholarship resulting in over a million dollars in additional offers totaling 6.4 million.
