

Out-of-Uniform Clothing Requirements

Students should follow these guidelines for any Dress Up Day or Appreciation Day. For rules regarding Spirit Days, please see the Dress Code standards in the Handbook.

Dress Up Days are not simply excuses to dress down. Students must dress according to the theme of the day. If not, students must be in normal dress code.

Modesty, tastefulness, and appropriateness are the foundation of these general guidelines.

- Students may wear skirts or shorts, as long as those items follow the theme of the day. Shorts or skirts must comply with the fingertip length rule addressed under Appearance Standards. If not, the clothing underneath that item (i.e. leggings, bike shorts, etc.) must extend beyond the fingertip.
- Spandex, leggings, or other tight-fitting clothing can never be worn alone.
- Jeans, sweat pants, warm-up pants, and khaki pants are all allowed.
- Appropriate accessories, such as shoes, socks, wigs, jackets, and sunglasses are allowed. However, those items must follow the theme for the day, and any facial covering must be easily removable and must not cover the entire face.
